## John 11:1-45

1 Lazarus was sick. Lazarus lived in the village of Bethany. He lived with his sisters, Martha and Mary. [Jesus was not in Bethany.] 3So Martha and Mary sent word to Jesus, "Lazarus is sick."

5Jesus loved Martha and Mary and Lazarus. 6But he did not go to Lazarus. He waited two days.

7Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's go. Lazarus is sleeping. I will wake him up. 13Actually, Jesus meant: Lazarus is dead.

- 12But the disciples did not understand Jesus. So the disciples said, "Lazarus is sleeping, so he will get well. [That is good.] " 14Then Jesus said, "Lazarus is dead."
- 15Jesus said to his disciples, "It is good that I did not go to Lazarus quickly. Now, you will believe in me. Let's go to Lazarus now."
- 17Jesus came to Bethany. 20Mary stayed in the house. But Martha went out of the village to meet Jesus. Martha said to Jesus, "You did not come quickly. So my brother died."
- 23Jesus said to Martha, "Your brother will live again." 24Martha answered, "I know my brother will live again on the last day he will live again at the resurrection."
- 25Jesus said, "I am the resurrection. I am the life."

Jesus said, "People die. But, if they believe in me, they will live again. 26Do you believe this?"

- 27"Yes, Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "I believe you are the Messiah. You are God's Son. God sent you to the world."
- 28Then Martha went back home and called Mary, "Jesus wants to see you." 29So Mary got up quickly and went to Jesus. 32Mary fell down at Jesus feet, [and Mary was crying]. She said, "You did not come quickly. So my brother died."
- 33Jesus saw Mary crying, and Jesus saw everyone with Mary crying. So Jesus was very upset. 35Jesus cried.
- 36Then the people said, "He loved Lazarus very much." 37But other people said, "Jesus healed a blind man now the blind man can see. Lazarus was sick couldn't Jesus keep Lazarus from dying? Couldn't Jesus make Lazarus well?" 38Again, Jesus was upset.

Jesus came to the tomb. The tomb was a cave. A big stone covered the entrance of the cave. 39Jesus said, "Take away the stone."

But Martha said, "Lazarus has been in the tomb for four days. It stinks." 40Then Jesus said, "Believe. And you will see God's glory." 41So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up to heaven, and he said, "Father, thank you for hearing me. 42You always hear me."

43Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" 44The dead man came out of the tomb. Cloths were wrapped around his face and hands and feet. Jesus said to the people, "Take off the cloths. Let Lazarus go."

45Many people saw this. They believed in Jesus.

What did Jesus promise to people who believe in him?

(the second half of verse 25)

• What did Martha believe about Jesus? (verse 27)

What do you think about Martha's faith?

• What did Jesus do when he saw Mary and everyone crying? (verse 35)

Jesus knew what he would do (verse 43)! So, why did Jesus cry?

Do you think God cares about our feelings?

Why (do you think) Jesus did different things with Martha & with Mary?

Does Jesus care about each person individually?

- Whom did Jesus talk to? (verses 41 & 42)
- What did Jesus do to Lazarus? (verse 43-44)
- What did many people think about Jesus? (verse 45)
