JESUS STOPS A STORM

Mark 4:35-41 [Luke 8:22-25]

35When evening came, Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's go across the lake." [22]So they got into a boat, and they started across the lake.

[23] As the disciples were sailing the boat, Jesus fell asleep.

37Suddenly, a bad storm came on the lake. The waves got very big. Water came into the boat. The boat was beginning to sink. [23]And they were in great danger.

38Jesus was in the back of the boat. He was sleeping on a cushion.

The disciples went to Jesus. They woke him up. And they said, "Teacher, don't you care if we die?"

39Jesus got up. He scolded the wind. And he said to the waves, "Be quiet! Stop!" Then the wind stopped. And everything was quiet.

40Jesus asked his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you have no faith?"

41[25]Then the disciples were very afraid and amazed. They asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"
